

United Women in Faith Reading Program

The United Women in Faith Reading Program is a cherished tradition that encourages members to explore, share and discuss books. There are books available for adults, youth, and children. Any member of UWF or our church family may access the books. You do not have to participate in the Reading Program. New books are added each year and can be found in the church library on the UWF library shelving unit. There is also a list of books available through our Longmont Public Library, either print or ebooks.

The Reading Program is designed to:

Educate, Inform, Encourage critical thinking and Lead to action

on multiple causes supported by our UWF local and International organizations through reading an annual selection of member-reviewed books.

In addition, UWF has two podcasts: **Faith Talks** and **Voices from the Field** which may be accessed through the uwfaith.org website. UWF's magazine "response," is also a part of the reading program and copies can be found on the UWF library shelving unit in the church library.

The books for the Reading Program are divided into five categories:

Education for Mission
Leadership Development
Nurturing for Community
Social Action
Spiritual Growth

The Reading Program allows books to be counted from the current year and the five previous years. There are five plans in the Reading Program and an explanation of the plans can be found on the UWF shelving unit in the library.

Reading of the books and listening to podcasts is encouraged for all interested in educating themselves in the fields nurtured and supported by UWF.
